Conditions of Entry

This entry form is to be sent in by the Competitors National Association. In the case of Australian players individual entries will be accepted, providing they are a member of an Association affiliated with Badminton Australia and the entry is endorsed by that Association.

All players submitting entries for the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which the tournament events are to be conducted. Competitors play at their own risk.

Rules & Regulations

1. The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Laws of Badminton adopted by the Badminton World Federation.
2. All players must be registered members of a body affiliated with the BWF and must be in good standing with their Member Association.
3. Any entry not appropriately authorised by an entrant's national organisation will not be accepted.
4. BWF regulations will apply in relation to withdrawals from the event.
5. Players must be under 19 years of age by December 31st, 2011.
6. Matches in the 2011 Australian Junior International will be officiated by qualified umpires. However, players may be requested to umpire or line judge in turn at the direction of the Referee.
7. Li-Ning Shuttles will be used.
8. All players must wear regulation badminton attire as per the BWF Competition Regulations 19. Non-marking shoes must be worn.

9. Seedings and Draw
 - a. The draw for the 2011 Australian Junior International will be conducted by Badminton Australia as soon as possible after the entry closing date and will be placed on the Badminton Australia website www.badminton.org.au and www.tournamentsoftware.com/sport/tournament.aspx?id=26627F6A-9F54-42E6-A35E-177238D06565
 - b. The seedings will be determined by a seeding panel appointed by Badminton Oceania and will take into consideration any available BWF Junior World Rankings
 - c. BWF regulations will apply in relation to withdrawals from the tournament.
 - d. Enquiries regarding starting times of matches are the responsibility of entrants. The timetable for the event will also be placed on the Badminton Australia and Ballarat Badminton Association websites.
10. All players must report to the Control Desk on arrival. The Referee will have the power to disqualify any player not available to play at the scheduled time.



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11. Withdrawals

Notification of withdrawal(s) with reason must be given immediately to Ballarat Badminton Association by fax or email and must be supported by a medical certificate. The organisers may require documentary evidence to support withdrawals for any other reason. If withdrawal arises after players have arrived at the venue, notification of withdrawal accompanied by supporting documentation must be made **IN PERSON** to the Referee or Deputy Referee.

12. Anti-doping regulations

The BWF Anti-Doping Regulations apply at this BWF sanctioned event. Players competing in this tournament are subject to ***in-competition drug testing*** under BWF Anti-Doping Regulations and the regulations and the provisions of the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority Act. Players are reminded that it is their obligation to submit completed Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) application forms to the BWF to get approval to use prescribed medications containing prohibited substances. In the first instance, contact your National Federation/Association. **Players are required to apply for TUE approval at least 21 days before the start of this international event.**
